Beginner and Advanced Beginner: Competitors must wear a school costume or a skirt and blouse (girls) or slacks and shirt (boys). 2 STEPS 2 DANCERS AT A TIME.

Treble Reel down the line (Open & Prelim Dancers Only)

BEGINNER - A beginner has not taken Irish dancing lessons from a registered teacher prior to 9/1 of the prior year. Dancer must move to Advanced Beginner the following year.				ADVANCED BEGINNER - Hornpipe & Hard Jig at traditional speed. An Advanced Beginner who wins 1st, 2nd, or 3rd place will advance to Novice category in that particular dance in the following year on 1/1. Competitions with less than 5 dancers will be combined with the next age bracket. Competitions could be combined depending on entries
